President's Message



To all of our new students and recent graduates: Welcome to the wonderful world of square dancing! If I haven't met you yet, I am Stephen Sworen, the current president of the Mount Baker Council of Square Dancing. The Square and Folk Dance Federation of Washington State is made up of ten councils (by Region). Our council stretches 91 miles from the Samena Squares in Kirkland to the Rainbow Squares in Lynden. We have 16 clubs including 10 Mainstream, 2 Plus, 1 Advanced, 2 Round Dance Clubs, and the Mt Baker Teachers, Callers, and Cuers. We will soon have a Youth club joining us! With nearly 600 members, we are the largest council in the state, and have dances nearly every Friday, Saturday and Sunday, and classes most days of the week.


The council is run by a board that's elected yearly in May, and each club sends two delegates to our monthly meeting, which is on the first Wednesday of the month (Sept-June) in Marysville. In the back of each issue of the Notes we publish the minutes of the last meeting, so everyone knows what is going on in our council!

When you join a club, \$1 of your dues goes to the Council, and \$6 goes to the State Federation. Most of that money pays for dancer insurance, so that if you are injured going to or from or at a dance, insurance is available!

The State Federation, Mount Baker Council, and all our clubs are non profit organizations. Our dance fees are donations. At every dance there is also a "Split the Pot" where half the winnings goes to the club. Please consider donating generously to this to increase your chances of winning, and to help the clubs make ends meet!

We hold two fundraisers each year, the Fall and Spring Council Dances. On May 31st, the Fern Bluff Squares will be hosting the dance (see back page) It is our biggest dance of the year, and you will get to meet members of all of our clubs, plus others from across the state and Canada. And this year's student get in for free!
