A kindred club also must have a distinctive name and name badges and must maintain a list of members.

- a. In a leader-run kindred club, all references in these By-Laws to Club Officers or Club Delegates shall refer to the dance leader.

Upon adoption of this amendment, renumber the current Section 1,A,2 and all subsequent subsections of this Article 1.

Discussion ensued. They must maintain a membership list, pay dues, submit necessary paperwork, and meet the requirements of our Council. No exclusion for dues or insurance.
